
1. Google Chrome Browser

1. To the right of the address bar, tap More tools.




2. Then tap Clear browsing data:

2. Click Clear Cookies and Site data.






3. Internet Explorer

1. In Internet Explorer, select the **Tools** button.




2. Click on Privacy, search, and services:






3. Then click on Clear Browsing Data and then Clear browsing data now:



4. Choose all the information below and click on **All Time**:






1. Press F12 on your keyboard and a new window will open on the right, down, or left. Or right-click on the page and click on inspect. This window is the Inspector.

4. Click over each option of this tree with the right button of your mouse, there'll be an option will be shown so that you can "Clear". Click over it and you will clean part of the browser's storage.




- 5. Repeat step 4 for Session Storage and Cookies options.


